CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME

THE NAME OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE THE GREATER SAN ANTONIO CHAPTER (GSAC), AN AFFILIATE OF THE TEXAS HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION (THSBOA).

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORGANIZATION IS TO PROMOTE INTERCOLLEGIATE AND INTERSCHOLASTIC BASKETBALL BY PROVIDING A GROUP OF EXPERIENCED AND CAPABLE BASKETBALL OFFICIALS TO SERVE THE STUDENT-ATHLETES OF TEXAS. THIS GROUP WILL FOSTER A HIGH STANDARD OF ETHICS, ENCOURAGE FAIR PLAY AND SPORTSMANSHIP, AND WORK TOWARDS CLOSER COOPERATION AND BETTER UNDERSTANDING AMONG OFFICIALS, SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, ATHLETIC DIRECTORS, COACHES, PLAYERS, AND SPECTATORS.

ARTICLE III - AUTHORIZATION

This organization is authorized and established under the by-laws of THSBOA and is therefore subordinate to those by-laws. The constitution and by-laws of this chapter, along with any amendments, shall not contradict or conflict with the by-laws of THSBOA. Furthermore, all members of the Greater San Antonio Chapter shall be governed first by the by-laws of THSBOA and second by the constitution, by-laws, and policies and procedures of this chapter.

ARTICLE IV - PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

THE RULES CONTAINED IN THE CURRENT EDITION OF ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER SHALL GOVERN THE CHAPTER IN ALL INSTANCES WHERE THEY ARE APPLICABLE AND NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS CONSTITUTION, THE CHAPTER'S BY-LAWS, AND ANY OTHER SPECIAL RULES THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MAY ADOPT.

ARTICLE V - AMENDMENTS

This chapter's constitution and by-laws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of a quorum of the chapter being present, provided the amendment was included in the call for the meeting.
